



School Uniform

School dress at Park Hill is a colour combination of navy, white and grey which make up our school uniform. Pupils are strongly encouraged to wear uniform which we feel adds a sense of identity to the school.

The uniform is:

Shoes	plain black (flashing lights not acceptable & any toys in heel should be removed)
Socks	grey (boys), white (girls)
Tights	grey only
Trousers/shorts	grey (boys) grey
Trousers	grey (girls)
Skirts / Pinafore Dress	grey "knee length"
Polo Shirts	white (KS1 only)
Shirts	white collared (KS2 only)
Pullover/cardigan	navy cardigan or navy "V" neck pullover including the Park Hill School logo (girls) navy "V" neck pullover including the Park Hill School logo (boys)
Tie	navy & gold stripe clip on
Hair bands	white or grey only

PE kit:

All children at the school are placed into one of four "House Teams"

Spencer (Red)
Coombe (Green)
Quinton (Yellow)
Gosford (Blue)

From **September 2025** children will require:

A house coloured t-shirt with white lettering (house name) on the reverse.
(optional) A 'house coloured' hoodie – lettering is not necessary
Black shorts (all children)
Black or navy joggers or tracksuit bottoms (optional for colder months only
e.g. November – February)

* Our experience indicates that short sleeved shirts are easier for young children to manage, especially when changing for PE or when doing practical activities involving paint or water.

The white polo shirts, white shirts, grey trousers and skirts are readily available from all the major chain store. We hope that parents will buy items in these colours when purchasing school clothes for their children. It is most important that sensible shoes are worn. For reasons of safety and security jewellery is not permitted except in the case of earrings which should be of the stud variety. Please ensure that all items of clothing are **named** either with a label or indelible pen.
