English

In English we will spend the first half term focussed on 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes writing an 'approaching threat' narrative and a non-narrative explanation text describing a trap. The second half term will focus on the book 'Fox' by Margaret Wild from which we will create our own fables and information texts about foxes. Our main focus in grammar this term is identifying subjects and verbs.

Maths

This term, our Maths lessons will cover place value, addition and subtraction, and multiplication and division. This will include estimating, comparing and ordering numbers to 1000; adding and subtracting two-digit and three-digit numbers using written methods (including the tricky concept of exchanging) and a focus on the 3, 4 and 8 times table, using both multiplication and division.

Wider Curriculum

Our Humanities theme in Year 3 is 'Infamous Britons' and this term we start with the Middle Ages, especially King John and King Edward I. We will focus on Magna Carta and how and why castles were built. There is special focus on Kenilworth Castle which is linked to both John and Edward. Our Science topics focus on the human body followed by forces and magnets and what makes materials reflective.

Challenge

In Art we are creating our own medieval illuminated letters. Can you find any books or pages that have a large, illustrated letter at the start of the page?
