English

We will be developing our writing skills through Ready Steady Write. We shall be writing a character narrative based on our text 'The Promise'. We will be looking at creating a character narrative. We will be looking at a range of adverbials and cohesive devices such as parenthesis to build description and tension. We are also going to be creating a bargaining letter in our non-fiction writing .

Maths

This term, we will develop our understanding of number and place value up to 1, 000, 000. We will look at written addition, subtraction and statistics (data). Number and place value includes rounding, comparing and ordering numbers, negative numbers and Roman numerals. We will also look into fractions and practise ordering, adding and subtracting fractions.

Wider Curriculum

This half term we will be focusing on the Romans and Vikings. Our Science topic is Materials and how they can be changed both reversibly and irreversibly into different states. In P.E we will be looking at creating a dance routine focussing on dynamics to accentuate movements.

In Art, we will be looking at portrait artists and we will be creating self-portraits before exploring Viking art.
